- Assign missions to others
- Follow up, assess support needs

4. Scene Size-up

- Assess the scene of the accident, what happened, and what dangers there are, and assess if the area is safe.
- Evaluate victims i.e. symptoms, number of people, gender, age.
- Assess the incident suppression team if they are ready, number of them, the equipment they have.

5. Incident Action Plan

- The objective means the desired outcome that leads to success in each task, within the framework of the responsibilities and goals set by the organization.
- Strategy means the planning of actions to achieve objectives, under appropriate environmental analysis or strategic analysis.
- Tactics refer to step-by-step methods of practice and training to achieve expertise and safety in the use of those tactics and equipment.
